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Introduction

The e-learning material introduces general military vocabulary in context so as the students that will attend the Common Module *Basic Military English* will be prepared to go deeper and acquire more specific military terminology, to get familiar with the issues they are going to come across in their military profession.

The e-learning consists of four lessons giving general information on *military ranks, weapons, vehicles and briefings*. At the end of each unit there is a self-evaluation section so as each student can assess himself/herself on the military terms that the future lessons deal with. There is a final self-evaluation at the end of the material so that each student can independently check his/her learning outcomes.
